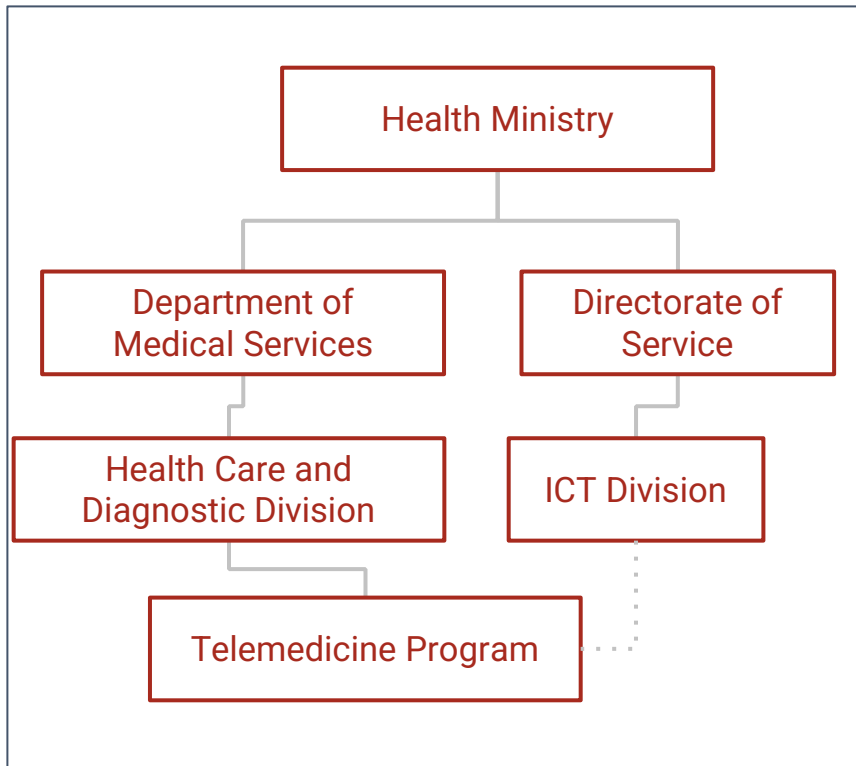

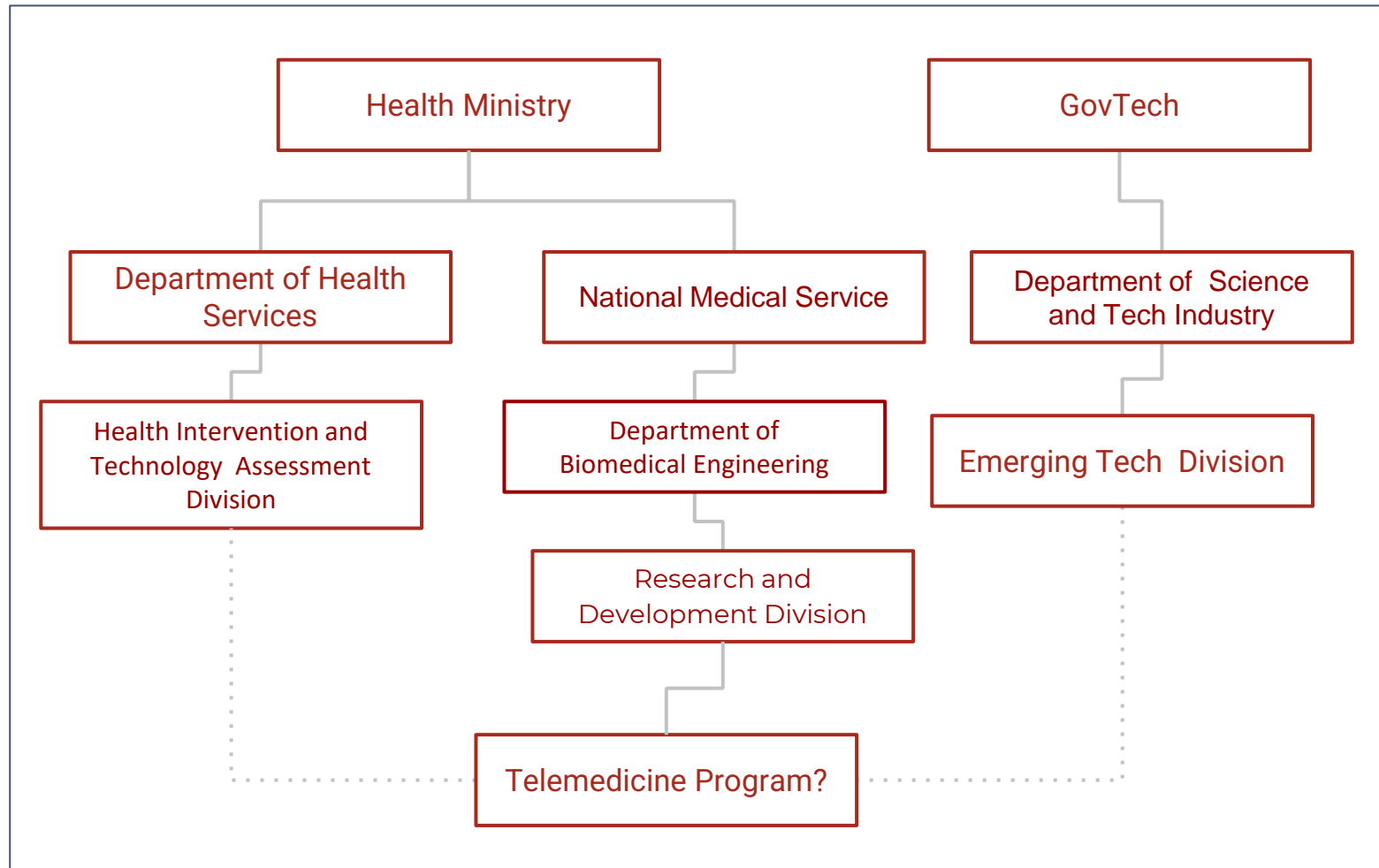

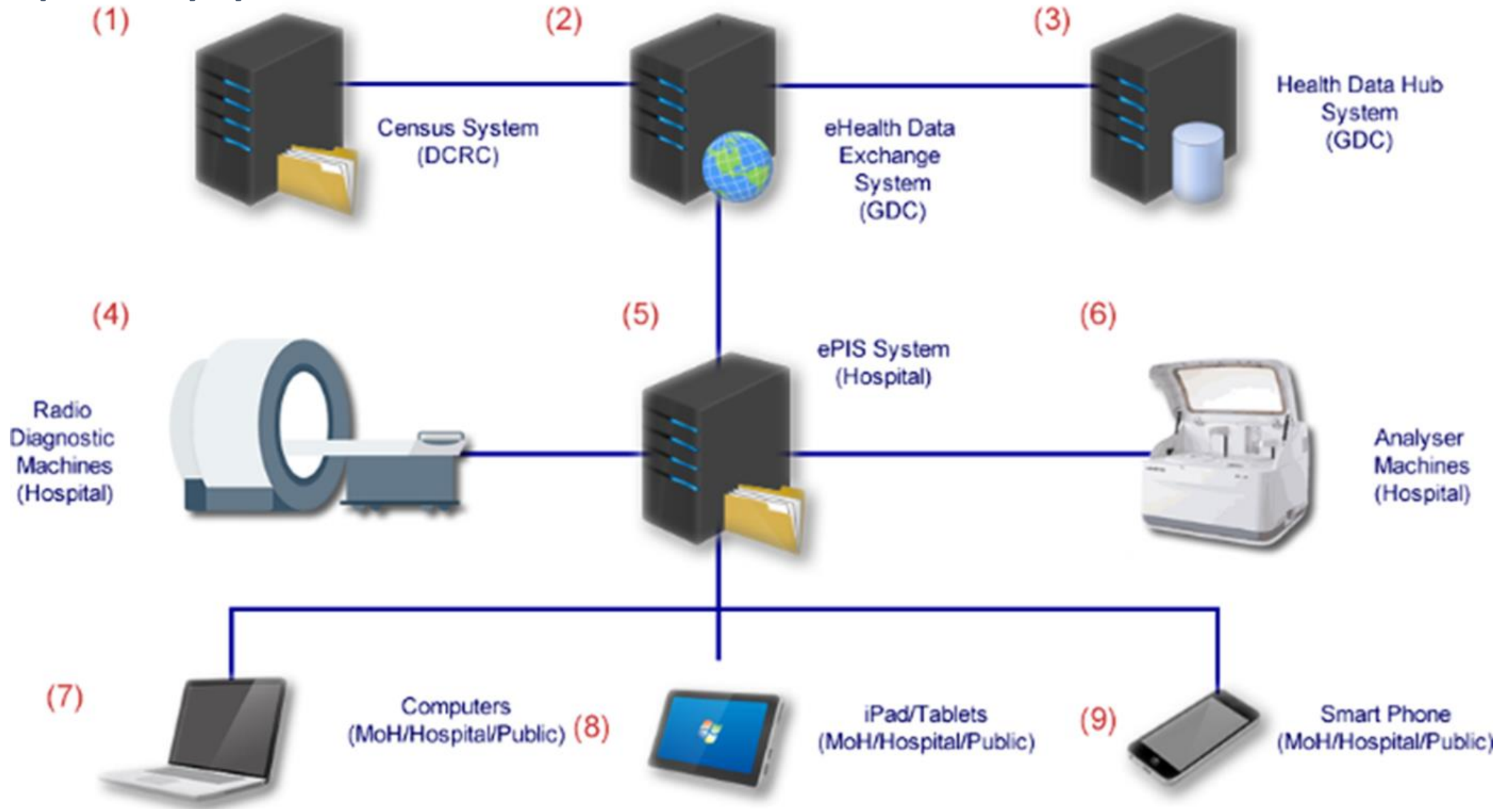
Key challenges in linkages and integrations of telemedicine services across national and sub-national levels, and across programme and disease areas

INTERVENTIONS

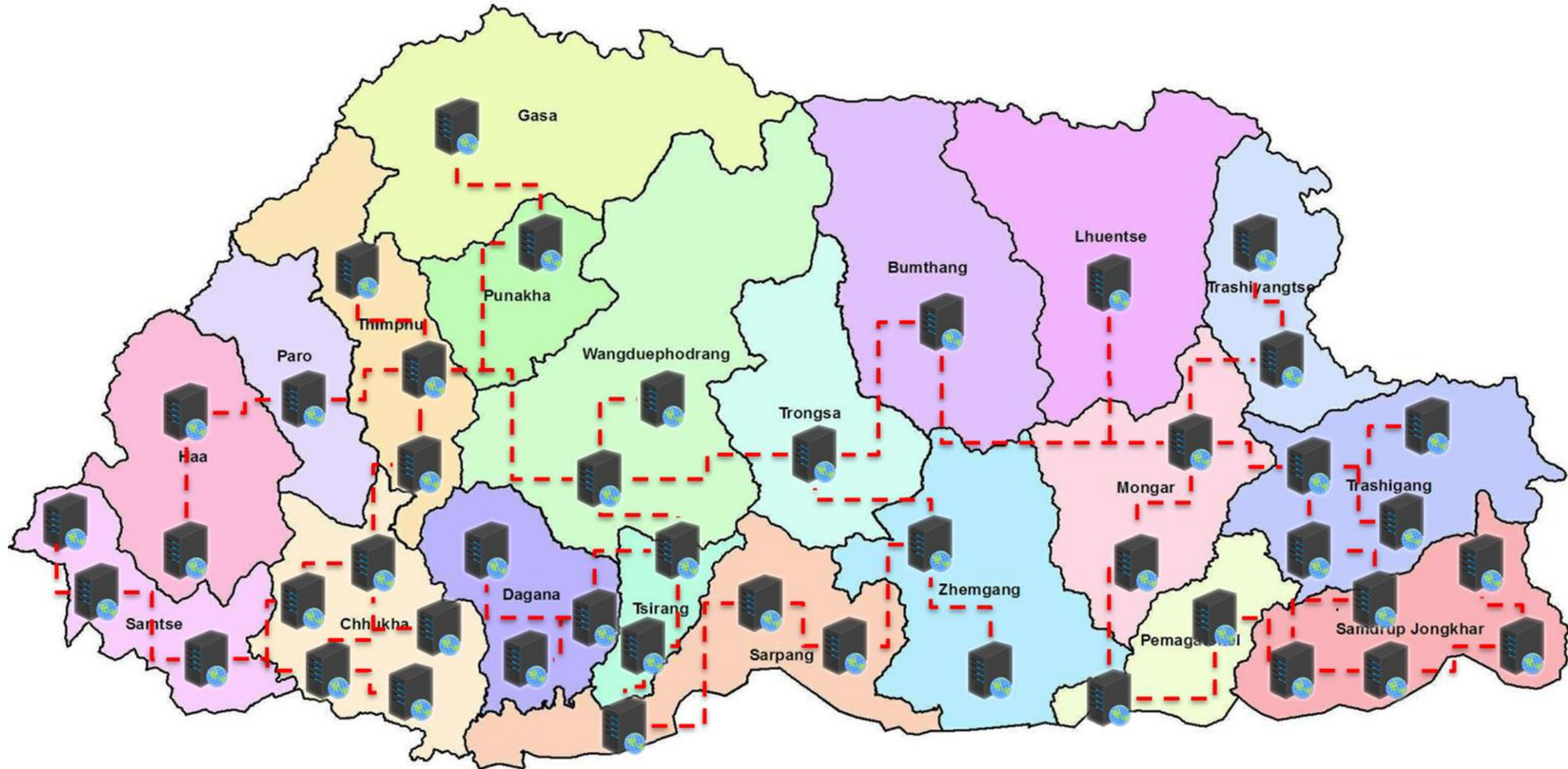
- GovTech Agency is exploring drones for logistics

Interoperability system:

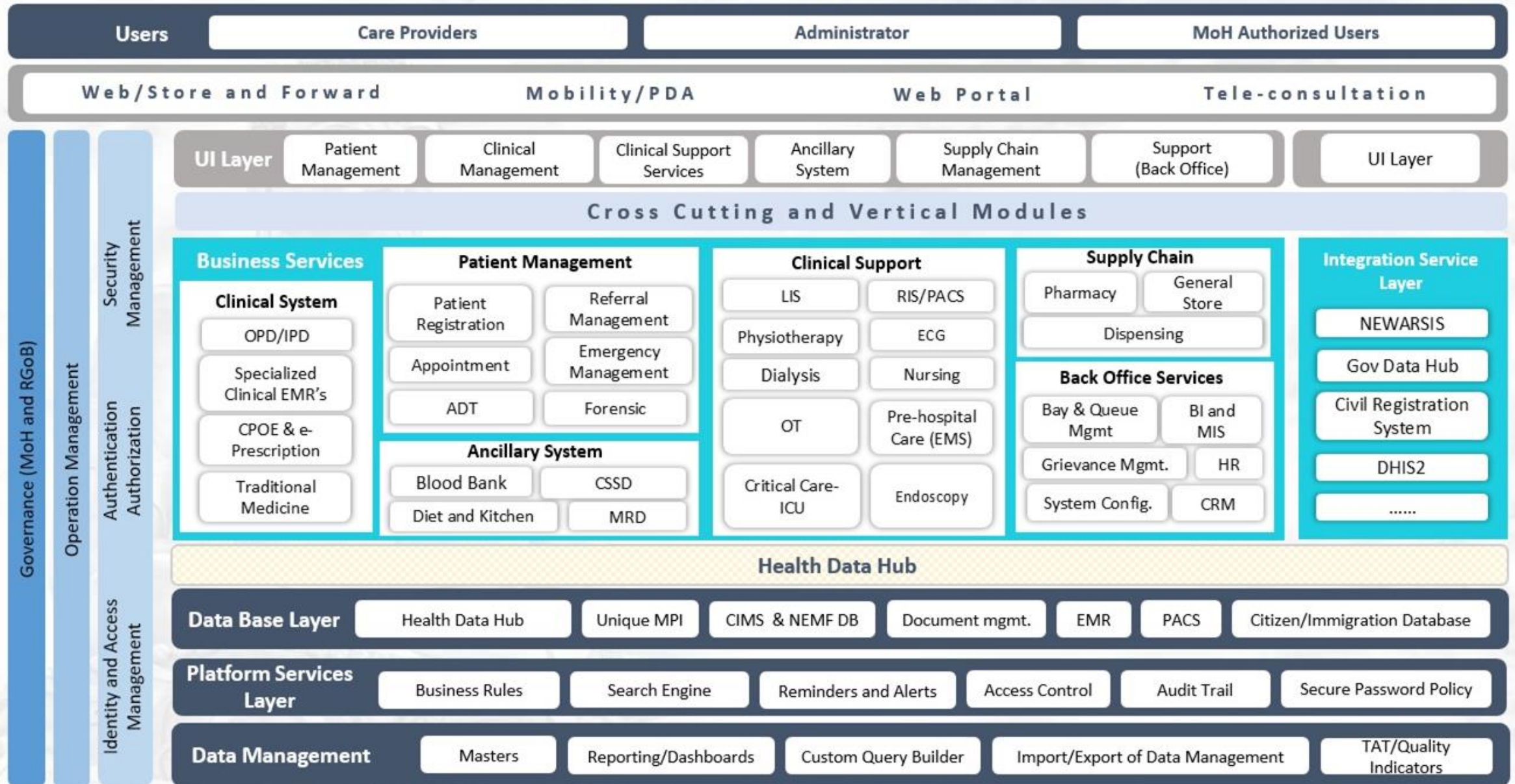


Nation-wide standard system:
